All first time participants in the **GLOBAL EDUCATORS PROGRAM** will be enrolled in a **six-semester credit** continuing education graduate course (CTED 876) titled **“Gaining a Global Perspective through Cultural Immersion”**. This course has been designed by the Program Director specifically to optimize each participant’s personal and professional growth through this highly personalized international teaching experience. Credit for the course will be offered through the University of St. Thomas, Minneapolis, MN; travel to the university will not be required to fulfill the requirements of the course.

**COURSE REQUIREMENTS: All course participants will fulfill three (3) of their credits by:**

- completing a minimum of three (3) weeks of **“teaching/shadowing”** (professional activity) in their assigned host school
- providing evidence of **focused, relevant preparation** for their international “teaching” assignment
- documenting their “teaching” experiences in a **Reflective/Insight Journal**, including daily entries and summarizing reflections

**COURSE OPTIONS: All course participants will fulfill their remaining three (3) credits by designing a PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN which integrates choices from the following:**

- involvement in **one or several seminars, workshops, or conferences that have an international or global education focus**, such as:

- completion of an **additional week** in the assigned host school .....
- design of **educational materials/project work** which infuse global content/perspectives into the curriculum, such as units of instruction, creation of culture boxes and related activities, “Day in the Life...” video project, etc. ....
- development of **in-service opportunities** for your US or international colleagues .....
- design of **collaborative projects** between your home and host schools/classrooms/colleagues, such as telecommunications projects, jointly-designed homepages, science/writing/cultural studies projects, etc. ....
- **comparative research** study/paper on topic(s) related to your educational field, such as teaching methodologies, special services, administrative roles, assessment procedures, etc. ....
- design of a **“special project”** which takes advantage of access to a “second country or region”, such as studying the arts (dance, music, art), environmental aspects/issues, or language dialects of a “neighboring” country .....
- development of an extensive **annotated bibliography** related to course objectives and Professional Development Plan .....
- **other proposed work** which would assist you in reaching your unique professional goals .....

Should you wish to modify your Professional Development Plan, please do so in writing so that a record of your modifications can be maintained in your file.

It is **strongly recommended that participants attend the Pre-departure Workshop**, a participation in the course/program. Attendance at that, or one of the other seminars, workshops or conferences, allows participants to interact with, and learn from the experiences of, other of educators who have, or will be participating in this or similar international teaching/travel programs. This interaction is viewed as a very important aspect of this unique learning experience!
